

**SPEED ORDINANCE
TOWN OF POWNAL, VERMONT**

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 1007 and 1008, it is hereby ordained by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Pownal, Vermont, that the following speed ordinance is adopted for the Town of Pownal, Vermont:

On the basis of our investigation, that the maximum speed limit of 25 MPH is considered reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist upon the following highway, we do hereby DETERMINE and DECLARE the following and safe maximum speed limit:

On T.H. #36, known as County Road, a maximum of 25 M.P.H. for the entire length.

On T.H. # 47, known as Schenkar Road, a maximum of 25 M.P.H. for the entire length.


On T.H. #35, known as Old Military Road, a maximum of 25 M.P.H. for the entire length.

The speed limit as herein above established shall be effective at all times of the day and night.


Any other ordinance or traffic regulation for T.H. # 35, #36, and #47 heretofore adopted by the Town of Pownal is hereby repealed.


This ordinance shall be published in the Bennington Banner on April 13, 2006 and shall be filed with the Pownal Town Clerk on April 7, 2006.


